

Dance Proms

Dance Proms was a unique collaborative project between three of the world's leading dance training and awarding bodies, the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing (ISTD), Royal Academy of Dance (RAD) and the International Dance Teachers' Association (IDTA). Held Annually at the Royal Albert Hall between 2009 and 2017, Julie Sianne Theatre Arts has been honoured to perform at the event on several occasions.

The School's first appearance at The Proms was in 2011 with the U15 S&D Group, "Dirty Laundry", and U12 Character Group, "The Circus". The school then performed in two more Proms. In 2013 with the U14 S&D Group, "Why Ain't It Always Summer" and the U14 Modern Group "Confusion" and then again in 2015 with the U21 Tap Group "I've Got Rhythm". Sadly The Dance Proms at the Royal Albert Hall is no longer taking place.

It was a truly magical experience to be part of this project and to be able to perform at one of the most famous and celebrated entertainment venues in the world.
