We look forward to seeing you to celebrate the festive season and to enjoy a complimentary glass of fizz.

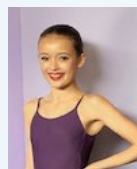


FoJSTA AGM and Cheese & Wine Social.

What have our students been up to?

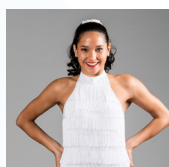


It has been a busy start to the term for students taking part in external events.

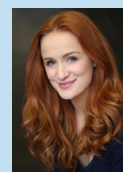
The first of this years AED Festivals was Tudor Rose in Fleet, with many students performing their dances for the first time.

Calista Manders and Samantha Osborne competed in the ISTD Tap Bursary Competition on Sunday 13th October in London.

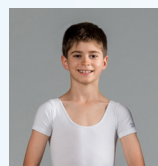


Joanna Gregory in Mary Poppins
