Evening of Dance 2020

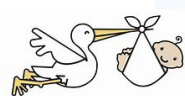

New Instructions from our Venue at BDB

From Monday 10 February parents and students can only enter the school building via the PE Corridor Doors or the North Corridor Doors at the rear of the school

There are no restrictions on parking. - Parking can be in either the front or rear car park. Please be mindful of how you park when using the rear car park.

The school now has electronic entry and exit gates installed. The entry gates will open 30 minutes before our classes start and will close 15 minutes at the end of our last class
